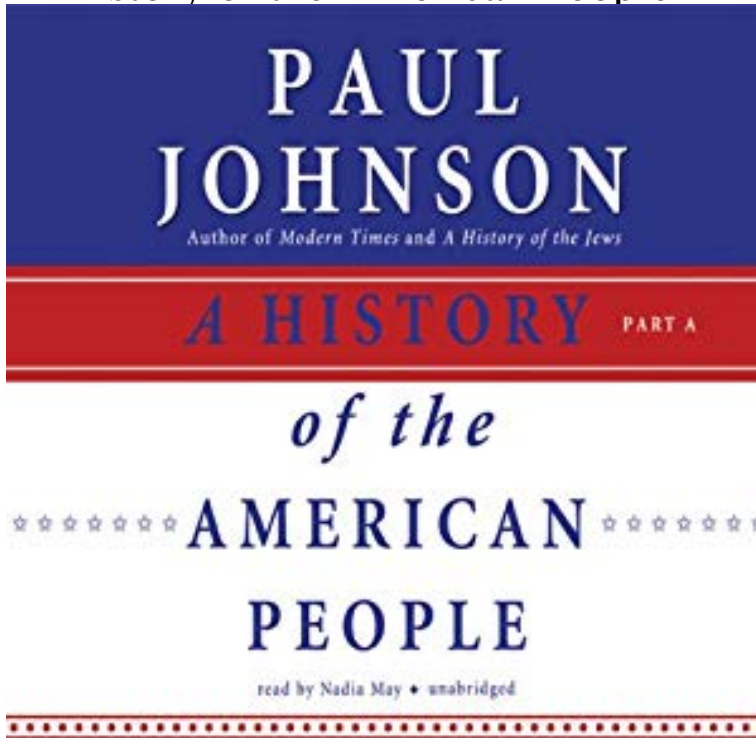


A History of the American People
